Welcome / ArtAngels 2021

It is with immense **gratitude** to our generous artists, suppliers and guests, and with great delight, that we once again open the doors of Ellerman House to welcome back friends and supporters for the **13th ArtAngels charity auction**.

With a new name and brand refresh, **Click Learning** remains the primary beneficiary of ArtAngels with 10% of the net proceeds flowing back into the arts via bursaries at the **Ruth Prowse School of Art** and funding for the **Blessing Ngobeni Art Prize**.

In 2017 the release of the Progress in International Reading Literacy Study (PIRLS) shon a damning light on literacy levels in South Africa indicating that **78% of grade 4 learners cannot read for meaning**. The 2019 Trends in International Mathematics and Science Study (TIMSS) showed that **63% of Grade 5 learners show no basic mathematical knowledge**. Furthermore, on the back of COVID-19 school closures, it is estimated that over **750,000 learners have not returned to school** according to the NIDS-CRAM Survey, while those that have returned have **lost over a year of teaching time**.

Based on these daming statistics, it is clear that we are facing a **catastrophic education crisis** for which South Africa will bear the burden for decades to come.

Click Learning is addressing these issues head on with our **foundational online literacy and numeracy programmes**. Having expanded our reach to over **130,000 learners** and **employed over 500 youth** to assist us in the schools, we have demonstrated the power of technology to deliver an **impactful and cost effective solution, at scale**.

With a budget of **R140m**, we plan to **reach over 250,000 learners** in 2022 and assist them to catch up on lost learning and cement foundational literacy, numeracy and digital skills such that they have a chance of a prosperous future. In addition we will employ and up-skill a further **330 unemployed youth** to enable this growth.

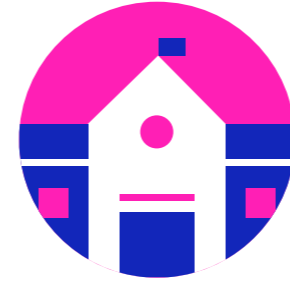

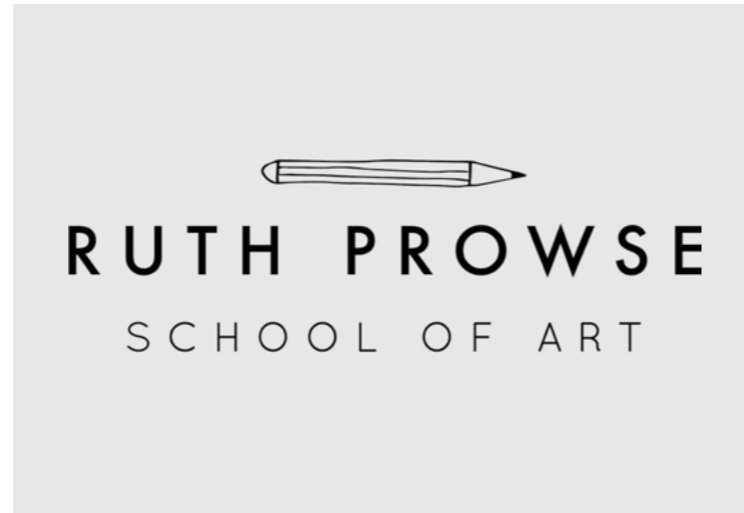
Beneficiary / BNAP Art Prize



In collaboration with the Bag Factory Artists' Studios, artist Blessing Ngobeni established the **Blessing Ngobeni Art Prize (BNAP)** in response to the positive impact on his career of winning the Cassirer Welz residency award at the Bag Factory in 2012.

The prize aims to assist **young and emerging visual artists** to launch their careers in the art industry and acknowledges excellence in emerging artists (under 35) specialising in sculpture, drawing and painting, or mixed media. The BNAP provides the selected artist with a twelve-week studio residency, materials budget, stipend and solo exhibition at the Everard Read Gallery Johannesburg. An art prize of this nature serves as a platform for encouraging an artist to transcend limitations within their craft much like Blessing Ngobeni.

The Ruth Prowse Art Centre was founded in 1970 by the renowned artist, Erik Laubscher which then became the **Ruth Prowse School of Art (RPSA)** NPC. The School has a vision to offer a balance between tradition and innovation and strives for excellence in the field of visual communication with an inter-relationship between theory and practice. The School is a world class environment that motivates original thought, creativity, aesthetics, cross-cultural artistic and educational exchange together with vocational and entrepreneurial skills.

The Everard Read ArtAngels scholarships at RPSA provides financial assistance to the most deserving students as adjudged by Ruth Prowse management and agreed by **Everard Read and ArtAngels**.

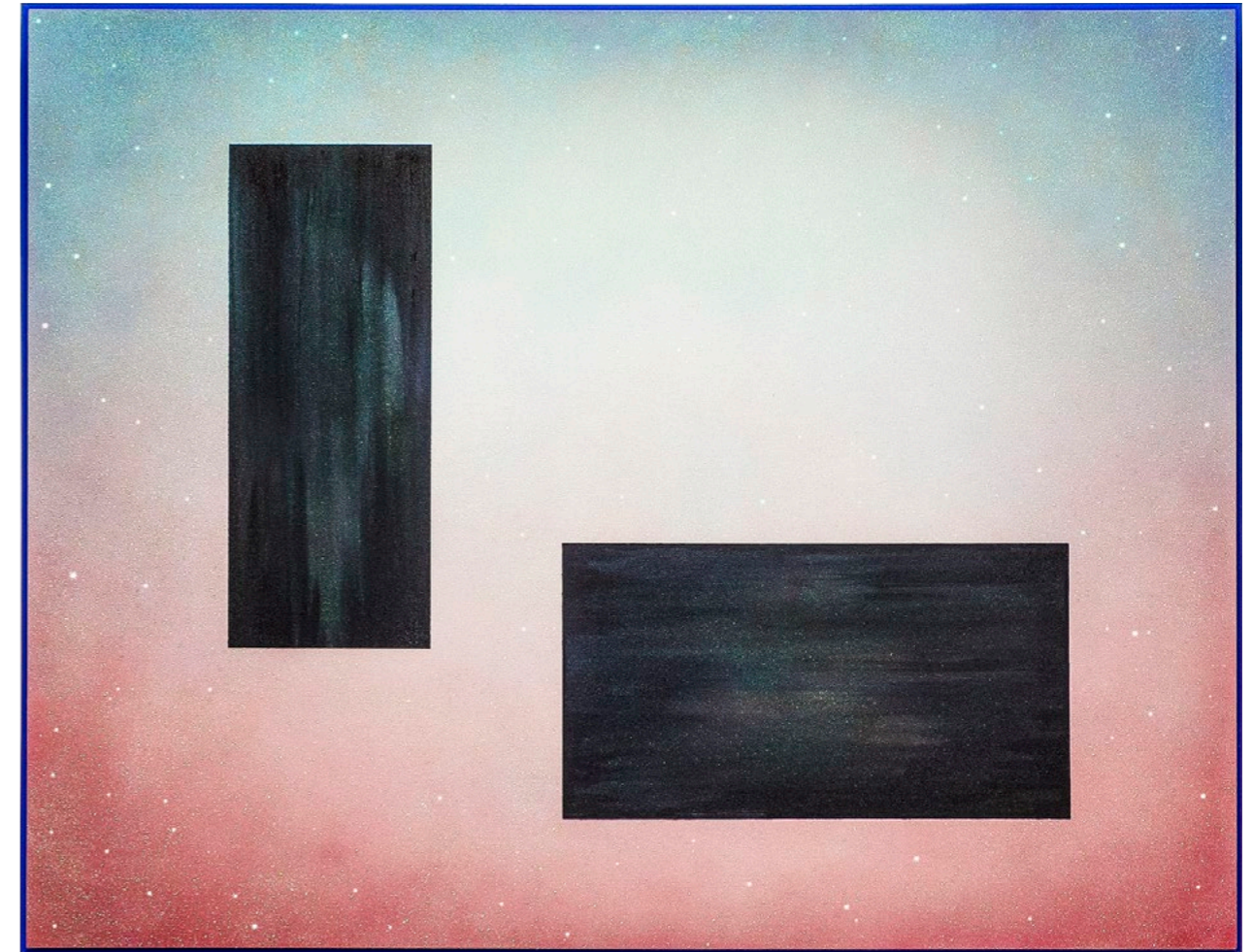

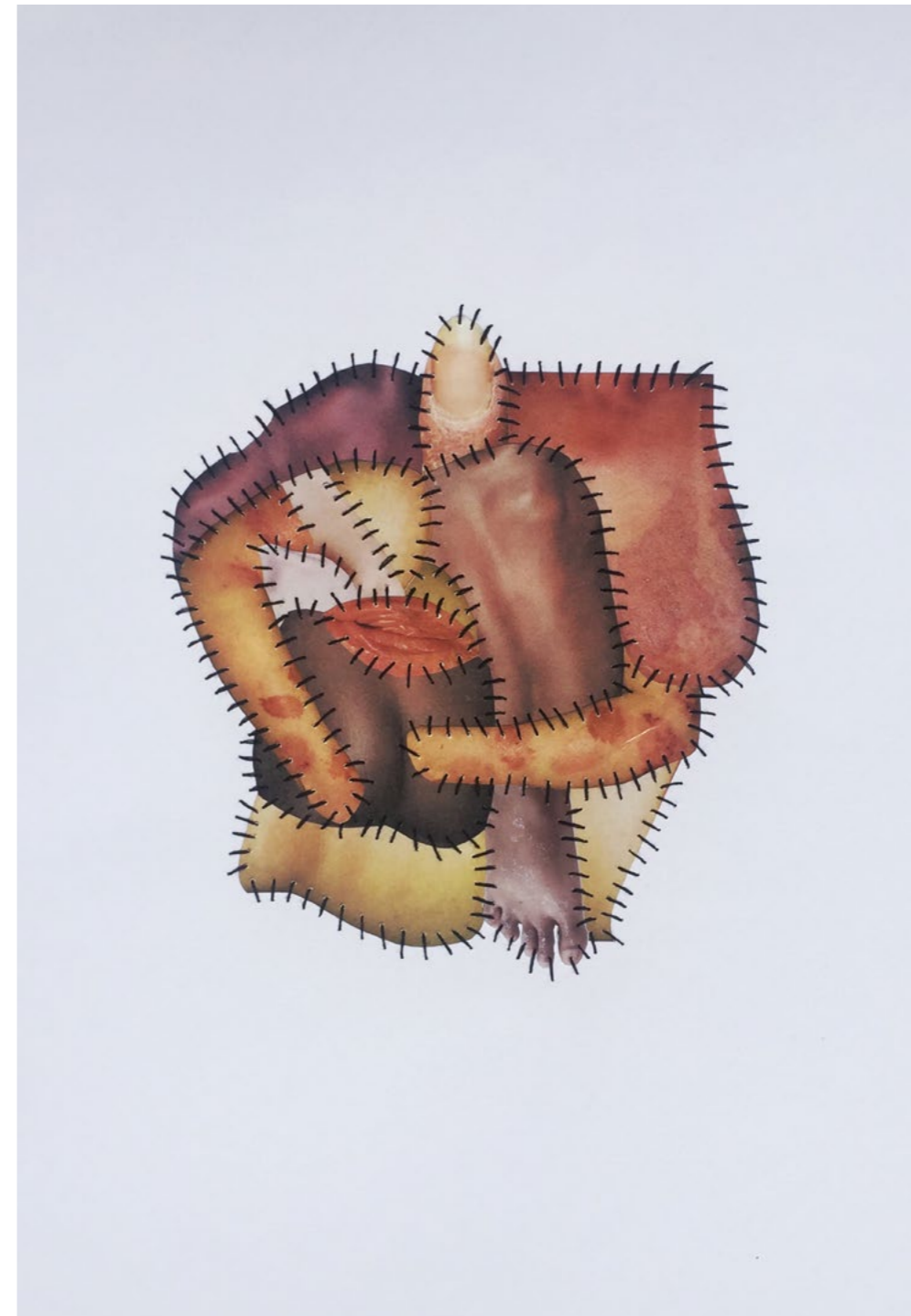
